MONDAY 02 APRIL

SYDNEY / BUENOS AIRES

Check in for your LAN Chile flight to Buenos Aires Argentina via Auckland & Santiago.

0940 hrs

Depart: Sydney

1740 hrs

Arrive: Buenos Aires.

After clearing local customs and immigration, meet your local guide and transfer to your centrally located hotel where you will be accommodated on a bed and breakfast basis for the next 5 nights.

FRIDAY 06 APRIL

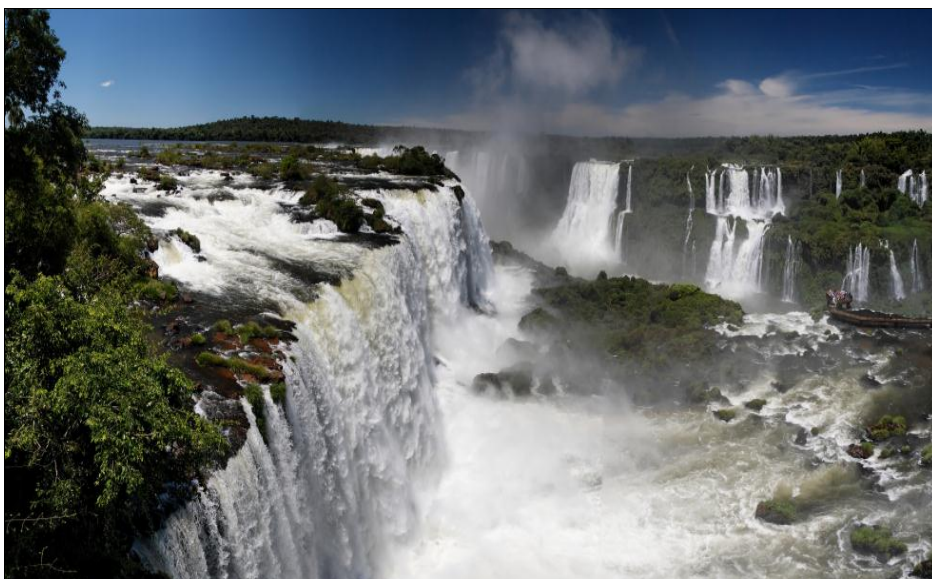
BUENOS AIRES

Full day Fiesta Gaucho Tour. Visit a typical Argentine Estancia (ranch) with the opportunity to experience the atmosphere of the country life. Taste an “empanada” (meat pie) and enjoy a traditional “asado” (barbeque). Enjoy the folklore music and dances, and watch a display of the riding abilities of the local “Gauchos” on their Creole horses.

This morning fly to magnificent Iguassu Falls which is one of the world’s most spectacular attractions. Spanning a 3km radius the falls have national parks on both Argentinean and Brazilian side which enables you to enjoy a guided tour of the many trails to explore the varied trees, plants and bird life (Note a visa is required to visit the Brazilian side of the falls).

At Ollantaytambo, a walking tour introduces you to a quaint village. Just outside of the town, admire the ruins of this mighty Inca fortress. Later, travel to your hotel in Yucay.



SUNDAY 22 APRIL

SACRED VALLEY / MACHU PICCHU

This morning, transfer to the train station for the Vistadome Valley train journey to Machu Picchu. There is time to explore the magnificent ruins of the "Lost City of the Incas" on your own after a guided walking tour with a local expert. Enjoy lunch before making the short trip to your hotel in Aguas Calientes, which is at the foot of spectacular Machu Picchu.

6 – 2 months prior to departure: \$1,000.00 per person

2 – 1 month prior to departure: 50% of total tour cost (airport taxes are refundable)

1 month prior to departure and after commencement of travel: Nil Refund

Please note there may be specialised inclusions in your tour such as Train Tickets, Theatre Show tickets, instant purchase airline tickets etc that are non-refundable in addition to the above Cancellation Charges. These cancellation fees are in addition to any cancellation fees that may be levied by our tour suppliers.
